Here is our published itinerary for the White Horses Ride, 2017!

Visits to 9 White Horse hill-cut figures in Wiltshire and Oxfordshire. Numbers in brackets are very rough estimates of mileage. contact either Angela or Caro for more details. (See below)

Friday 7th July: Westbury to Easterton (12)

no 1: Westbury White Horse

Saturday 8th July: Easterton to Lockeridge (16)

No 2: Alton Barns white horse

Sunday 9th July: Rest day

Monday 10th July: Lockeridge to East Grafton (via Savernack Forest) (14 miles in 1/2 petal)

Tuesday 11th July: East Grafton to Lockeridge via Pewsey white horse (12 miles 1/2 petal)

No 3: Pewsey White Horse

Wednesday 12th July: Lockeridge and back to lockeridge via Marlborough white horse (14 miles in 1/2 petal)

No 4: Marlborough White Horse

Thursday 13th July: Lockeridge to Headington (10)

no 5: Devizes White Horse

Friday 14th July: Hampsley Hollow to Lockeridge via Cherhill (look out for crop circle identified in April?) (15)

no 6: Cherhill White Horse

Saturday 15th July: Lockeridge to Broad Hinton

no 7: Hackpen White Horse

Sunday 16th July: Broad Hinton to Liddington (Towards Uffington)

no 8: Broad Town White Horse

Monday 17th July: Liddington to Woolstone, (Uffington).

Tuesday 18th July: Woolstone (Rest day) gathering on Dragon Hill to create a Mandala for Peace. (See 'events page' on Facebook for details or contact Angela or Caro for more details)

No 9: Uffington White Horse

Wednesday 19th July Woolstone back to Warren Farm

Thursday 20th July Warren Farm to Lockeridge

Friday 21st July Tidy up and take horses home
